The tuition for the school is \$75. This is just the school fee and does not include your 2010 umpire registration fee. This is an ASA event and will require all attendees to be ASA registered umpires for either the 2009 year or 2010 year. This school is not to be considered a registration clinic. Those will be held in various locations in South Florida during the month of February.

Students will receive classroom and on field instruction by some of the finest instructors in the ASA. Classroom instruction will entail lecture, power point, video and more. On field instruction will take place each day and will be assisted by youth teams helping with live drills, game situations and pitching.
