INTRODUCTION

The first step toward managing your *South Florida ASA* non-championship play travel team is the registration of the team with the *South Florida ASA* organization. You must do this by completing the *2009 Junior Olympic Non-Championship Play Registration Invoice* and mailing that form along with your \$25.00 registration fee to the address listed on the form.

Please make your \$25.00 registration fee check payable to ***SOUTH FLORIDA ASA***.

Your team is not eligible for Championship Play. You are registering your team only for the purpose of attending invitational and/or exposure tournaments inside and/or outside of the South Florida ASA area.

When the *2009 Junior Olympic Non-Championship Play Registration Invoice* is received by *South Florida ASA*, you will be provided with one *ASA Non-Championship Roster* form, the *Official Rules of Softball* (Team Edition) rulebook, and a scorebook.

PLEASE NOTE: Players on your roster are still eligible to be picked up by a Championship Play team once they have completed the individual registration process of a Championship Play team.

Your registration fee DOES NOT include team and/or individual insurance. You are responsible for securing your own insurance.

TRAVEL PERMIT

You are required to provide an *ASA Travel Permit* as part of your registration for any non-championship play tournament outside of the *South Florida ASA* area. Please make your request for an *ASA Travel Permit* by using the *South Florida ASA* website.

CONVERSION TO CHAMPIONSHIP PLAY

If you should decide to enter championship play, then you must register your team as either a Class “A”, “B”, or “Gold” team using the online registration of www.registerasa.com.

You can help us help you by following a few simple suggestions when you leave a message:

1. Be sure to leave your name, your team’s name, and a phone number(s) where you can be reached.
2. *Include the reason for your call.* Leave information as specific as possible so that we can get the information you need before returning your call.
3. Don’t ask “*what if*” scenarios. Tell us the name of the player you’re talking about and exactly what you’re trying to do.
4. Let us know how early/late it is okay to call.
5. **Do not call multiple staff members with the same question.**
